Jerritt Elliott (University of Texas Head Coach & 2008 U.S. National A2 Team)

Jerritt Elliott – Two times Central Regional Coach Of The Year, two time Big 12 Coach Of The Year, two time Pacific Coach Of The Year, and two time PAC 10 Coach Of The Year.

Elliott has taken the University of Texas Women's Volleyball team from a Nationally non-ranked team to the fourth (4th) ranked team in the Nation. He is among an elite group of coaches who have taken two different Universities to a Division I Final Four Championships.

The Longhorns posted a 29-4 record on the 2008 year and earned their second straight share of the Big 12 title. The trio of Ashley Engle, Destinee Hooker and Lauren Paolini garnered All-America First Team honors, marking the most first-team honorees in the University of Texas program history. His 2009 season has great promise to continue his exceptional winning record as he returns with three First Team All Americans and the Nations number one and number five 2009 recruits. Elliott has a keen eye for recognizing young talent. He has a reputation as one of the nation's best recruiters. In addition, Elliott is noted for his coaching skills and for developing All-Americans.

Elliott played collegiate volleyball at Pepperdine in 1986-88 and at Hawaii during the 1989-90 season. As a Pacific Palisades, California native he attended Palisades High School where he help lead his Palisades team to a 36-0 record in his final season. Elliott received All-LA, City second team selection honors.

Elliott is married to Sarah Silvernail Elliott and they have three little athletes, Kahle 10 years, Parker 3 years and Mack 2 years.

It is fitting Jerritt Elliott has been named the Founder and Board Chairman of the Youth National Volleyball Association (YNVA) as he establishes another chapter in his life by bringing the YNVA Youth Volleyball program to young children who aspire to learn volleyball from one of the best.
